In May 2017, TMS Ltd commenced work at Cremyll View in Cornwall for Cornwall Council, carrying out repairs to the damaged sea walls at four separate locations on the Mount Edgcumbe Estate - England's largest Country Park.

Work is anticipated to be completed in August 2017 and has, so far, included minor re-pointing, the rebuilding of masonry walls and underpinning at three out of the four locations.



The fourth location, at Mount Edgcumbe Quay itself, was the site of a more serious failure that is currently involving the complete rebuild of an 8m long section of sea wall, using reclaimed limestone and granite blocks. This rebuild is taking the form of a masonry-faced plain concrete gravity retaining wall, much of it being within the intertidal zone.

Mount Edgcumbe Country Park is a popular destination for locals and tourists alike. The Park runs a busy programme of events throughout the spring and summer months. All works have therefore had to be programmed and completed around events being held in differing parts of the Estate. Additionally, one of the work locations is the site of the live berth for the Cremyll foot passenger ferry, which at peak season has boats landing every 15 minutes. Works are currently predicted to finish ahead of programme and under budget.
