Requirement:

Demolition and reconstruction of the Banjo Promenade, Torquay.



Solution:

With the restriction that all materials and debris had to be delivered and removed by sea, TMS used skips and a barge to transport materials and debris to a nearby working quay.

Working with **Dawnus**, the principle contractor and following the successful completion by TMS Maritime of the Eastern Promenade in 2012, TMS undertook the demolition and rebuilding of the Banjo Promenade in Torquay, a traditional landmark and public facility, which had been closed for a number of years, due to concrete decay.

The contract required new concrete to be attached to the existing base, to form reinforced concrete columns, with pre-cast beams. As part of the design a new concrete deck was cast in situ. For QA purposes, the concrete was delivered to site overland.
